

**Minutes of the meeting of Seaton Ross Parish Council held on
Friday 25 October 2019**

A Parish Council meeting was held in the village hall on Friday 25 October 2019 at 7.30pm.

Members present: J Henley (Chair), R Underwood, G Gardham, K Wealleans, R Chapman, C Hunt, D Gascoyne and C Curran.

51/19 Declarations of interest – None.

52/19 Minutes – Agreed – that the minutes of the meetings held on 13 Sept 2019 be approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

Matters arising – Minute 40/19 – Wooden bench – this had been removed and was stored at Cllr Johnson's work premises.

53/19 Bank mandate form – Agreed that the clerk be added to the bank signatories and the form returned to the bank.

54/19 Extinguishment and concurrent creation order – footpath No. 11 – Mains Lane – No comments.

55/19 VE Day – Agreed that:

- a. Cllr Henley would speak to the Village Hall committee about a possible celebration of VE day and would book the village hall for 8 May 2020.
- b. Cllr Chapman would ask the Playing Field Committee if they would to contribute to the day.
- c. Cllr Curran would place an article in the Seaton Ross Times publicising the event.

56/19 Pavement surfaces – Agreed that the Clerk ask East Riding of Yorkshire Council Highways to slurry the pavements throughout the village.

57/19 State of the road since resurfacing – Agreed that the Clerk request Highways carry out a site visit to Seaton Ross to inspect the roads and drains due to the increased amount of standing water since improvements to the road surfaces were carried out.

58/19 Village sign planters – These were in the process of being built. **Agreed that the clerk would ask Rolawn to contribute the soil required for the planters (1 x large bag).**

59/17 Cycling through the village – Agreed that the Clerk:

- a. would contact the event organiser of the triathlon cycling events to ask them to remind competitors to observe highway safety and be aware of other road users when racing; and
- b. would place a link to Allerthorpe Lakeland Park website on the parish council website to enable residents to check the dates of events.

60/19 Storage container – deferred to the next meeting.

61/19 Speeding through the village – The Clerk had contacted ERYC who had informed them that no additional signage was permitted in the village. **Agreed that:**

- a. an article would be placed in the Seaton Ross Times to inform the parish that repeater speed signs were not permitted and requesting all followed the speed limits.
- b. Cllr Curran to look at whether a member of the Safer Roads Partnership would attend the annual meeting of the parish council in May 2020.

62/19 Overview and Scrutiny topics – no suggestions.

63/19 Hagg Bridge update - ERYC had informed the clerk of East Cottingwith Parish Council that the road would be closed when work to the bridge was carried out. No dates were available as yet.

64/19 Planning consultations –

- a. 19\02851\PLF – Land to the north west of the Black Horse Pub, South End – **No comments.**

65/19 Planning notices – Noted.

66/19 Parish Council Accounts – Noted as current account £4734.62; savings account £2511.76.
