A Parish Council meeting was held remotely on Tuesday 3 November 2020 at 7.30pm.

63/20 Declarations of interest – None.

64/20 Minutes – Agreed – that the minutes of the meeting held on 22 September 2020 be approved and signed by the Chairman.

65/20 Councillor vacancy for co-option – Agreed that the vacancy to co-opt onto the Council would continue to be advertised on Facebook, the website, the notice board and Seaton Ross Times.

66/20 Halloween competition – members selected the winners and runners-up. **Agreed that Cllr Underwood would purchase an additional £5 book token so all entrants could receive a prize.**

67/20 State of the footpaths at the south end of the village – Deferred to the next meeting.

68/20 Hagg Bridge Update – there were ongoing delays with the bridge with no firm date to re-open. **Agreed Seaton Ross would write a joint letter to ERYC together with East Cottingwith, Melbourne and Sutton-upon-Derwent Parish Councils.**

69/20 Yorkshire Water Update – Main Street, Melbourne, was now open.

- a) Cllrs Henley and Gardham to check prices of a tree and wildflower seed for VE/VJ day for the parish plot; and
- b) Cllr Wealleans to purchase bulbs for the planters on South End.

71/20 Works to East Common Lane – members raised concerns that the repairs to East Common Lane need to be more substantial given the poor state of the road following the Yorkshire Water works in Melbourne. **Agreed the Clerk would write to ERYC about the proposed works on East Common Lane.**
